MINUTES OF THE MEETING held at Stowmarket Leisure Centre, Stowmarket Friday 01 December 2017.

Minutes of the meeting of 15 September 2017: The minutes of the meeting having been circulated and were signed as a true record.

Matters arising: No matters arising.

Finance:

Tony Cheatham had produced an income/expenditure sheet which was handed to those present. On the Network side £600 has been paid out in bursaries. There is an outstanding bill from Ipswich Borough Council for the last Sportshall competition but there should be some income from this.

Track and Field:

- Northgate Track is booked for the County Championships on 14 May 2018. First Aid etc to be booked and this will be done in the near future.
- The County needs to apply for its own permit this year for these championships as the previous 'block permit' for Counties is not being applied for.
- JC brought the Committee's attention to the fact that if Northgate School becomes an academy in the future, the future of the track could/may be in question.
- The CAU Championships are on the 28/29 July 2018 and will be in Manchester. It is unlikely that Suffolk will send a team.

Cross Country:

- JM and PF have to Culford and measured the courses. They will be different to the schools' event. There will be 2k and 4k looks and a 1k loop for the youngsters. JM is awaiting to replies from Officials and then he will send the list out.
- JM reported that Lewis Sullivan of St Edmunds Pacers finished 2nd in the U13 boys race at the Cross Challenge, Liverpool; Tilly Aldis of Ipswich Harriers was 17th in the U15 girls and Emily Moyes was 26th. In the Cross Challenge at Milton Keynes Lewis was 2nd and Tilly Aldis was 15th.

Road Racing: Report from Trevor Bunch Suffolk Grand Prix:

- Race 5 was the Simplyhealth Great East Run HM held on Sunday 24th September. A total of 2416 runners took part, of which 399 were eligible for the GP (162 female and 237 male).
- Race 6 was the Martlesham 10K held on Sunday 8^{th} October. A total of 432 runners took part, of which 205 were eligible for the GP (77 female and 128 male).
- Race 7 was the Stowmarket Scenic 7 held on Sunday 12th Nov. A total of 423 runners took part, of which 248 were eligible for the GP (123 female and 125 male).

• The final GP race of this year is the Turkey Trot on Sunday 10th Dec.

Sportlink Running & Fitness have confirmed that they will once again sponsor the GP series in 2018.

Trophies for GP and County Championships

The amount charged for inclusion in the GP and County Champs was questioned at the fixtures meeting in September. I can now confirm that the cost of this year's trophies is entirely covered, and with a suplus of £90. Breakdown below.
