



## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **ATHLETICS COMPETITION DIRECTOR**

#### **Overview**

The Athletics Competition Director (ACD) will have overall responsibility for the delivery of successful Sainsbury's Suffolk School Games Level 3 Quadkids and Super8 finals.

The ACD must be available to run this event on Friday 10th July 2015, between 8am-5pm and able to travel to Bury St Edmunds.

This is a voluntary role but expenses may be paid on agreement with Suffolk Sport prior to accepting this position. Lunch and light refreshments on the day will be provided.

#### **Job Role**

The key elements of the role are as follows;

*Preparation (in conjunction with Suffolk Sport where indicated)*

- ◆ Collating and inputting school's entry data into spreadsheets (Suffolk Sport)
- ◆ Coordinating lead volunteers for each event
- ◆ Arranging for appropriate equipment to be available (Suffolk Sport)
- ◆ Ordering participant identification numbers (Suffolk Sport)
- ◆ Create event timetable, including grouping of participants

*Event Day*

- ◆ Setting up for the event
- ◆ Volunteer briefing
- ◆ School and Participant briefing
- ◆ Running of the competitions (including management of result collection)
- ◆ Management of volunteer workforce throughout the day
- ◆ Point of contact for all athletics event volunteers
- ◆ Settle/Arbitrate on any disputes and or questions from team managers

Knowledge and understanding of Quadkids and Super8 competitions (essential)  
Excellent organisational and communication skills  
Confident and approachable manner  
Experience in managing a workforce (desirable)
